The primary investment objective of the fund is to maximise total returns over the longer term at the risk of greater short term volatility of capital values.

Fund Universe

The fund will, apart from assets in liquid form, consist solely of participatory interests in Collective Investment Schemes.

The fund will invest in a flexible combination of equities, bonds, cash and property, both local and foreign. No guidelines have been set for maximum and minimum exposures and as such the manager shall have the maximum flexibility to vary assets between the various markets, asset classes and countries to reflect the changing economic and market conditions.

The investment manager will be permitted to invest on behalf of the fund in offshore investments as legislation permits.

Due to the flexible nature of the fund, no asset allocation limitations will apply.

Commentary

The fund capitalised nicely from the significant Rand weakness over the last quarter, which underpinned the funds strong performance.

Global markets remain tentative due to the uncertainty surrounding the trade war, Brexit and the long bull market experienced in the US.

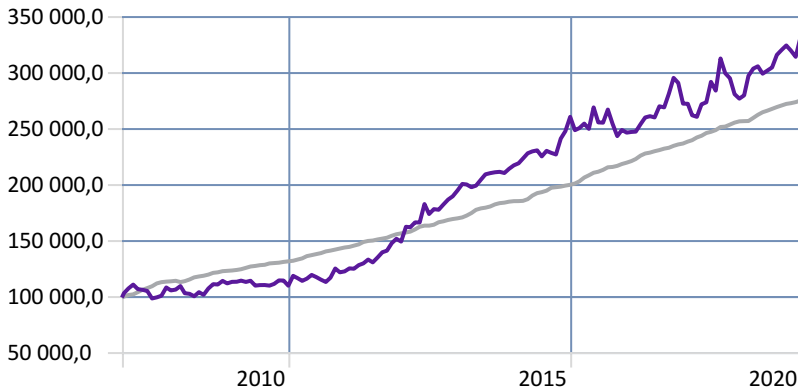

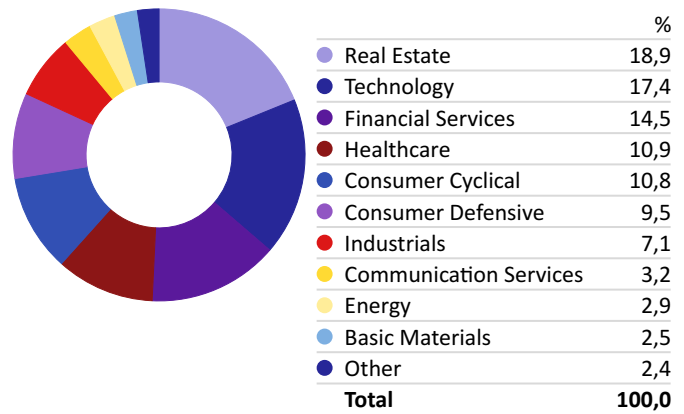

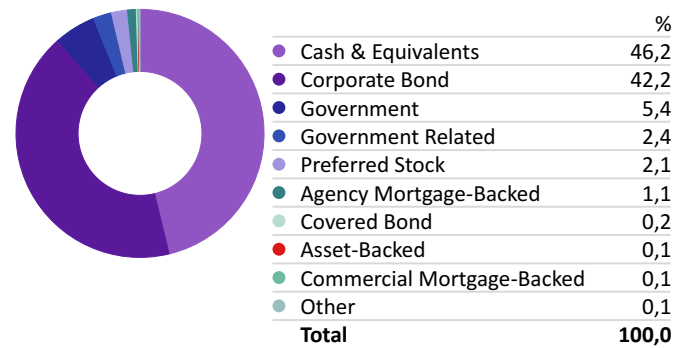
Equity Sector Allocation

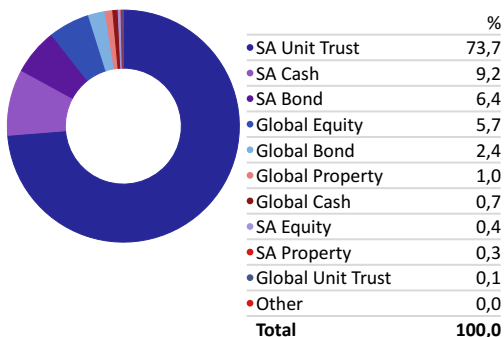

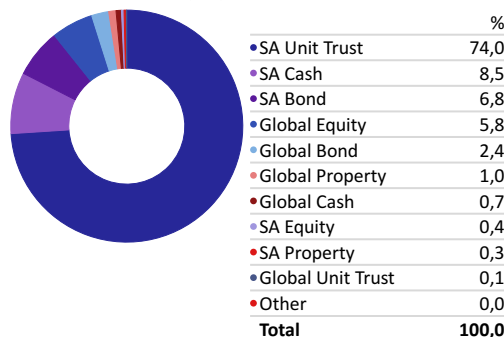

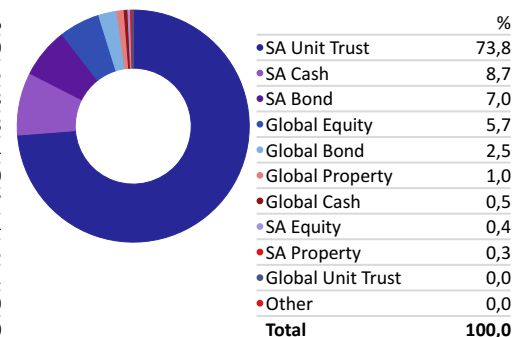

Glossary of Terms

Total Investment Charge (TIC) is the sum of the Total Expense Ratio (TER) and the Transaction Costs (TC).

TER is the global standard used to measure the impact that the deduction of management and operating costs has on a fund's value. It gives you an indication of the effects these costs have on the future growth of your investment portfolio. A higher TER does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. Also, the current TER may not necessarily be an accurate indication of future TERs.

TC is a necessary cost in administering the fund and impacts fund returns. It should not be considered in isolation as returns may be impacted by many other factors over time including market returns, the type of fund, the investment decisions of the investment manager and the TER. Calculations are based on actual data where possible and best estimates where actual data is not available.

Std Deviation (Standard Deviation) is a statistical measure of the dispersion of returns for a given security or market index.

Max Drawdown is the maximum loss from a peak to a trough of a portfolio, before a new peak is attained. Max drawdown is an indicator of downside risk over a specified time period.

Sharpe Ratio is a measure for calculating risk-adjusted return. It is the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of total risk.

The Brantam funds are registered under the Prime Collective Investment Scheme, managed by Prime Collective Investment Schemes Management Company (RF) (Pty) Ltd ("the manager") (Registration No. 2005/017098/07), a registered Collective Investment Schemes Management Company in terms of the Collective Investment Schemes Control Act 45 of 2002, supervised by the Financial Sector Conduct Authority ('FSCA'). Brantam Financial Services Holdings (Pty) Ltd is the FSCA approved and appointed investment manager of the Brantam funds situated at 12 Montrose Avenue, Craighall Park and authorised as a Financial Services Provider (License No. 544).

Collective Investment Schemes ("CIS") in securities are generally medium to long term investments. Investment performance is calculated for the portfolio and is for illustrative purposes only. The investment performance may differ for each investor as it is calculated by taking into account the initial fees, the actual investment date, the date of reinvestment of income and dividend withholding tax and all ongoing fees. Dealing prices are calculated on a net asset value and auditor's fees, bank charges and trustee fees are levied against the portfolios. Lump sum investment performances are quoted. Income distributions are in the calculations. The reinvestment of income is calculated on the actual amount distributed per participatory interest by using the ex-dividend date NAV price of the applicable class of the portfolio, irrespective of the actual reinvestment date. Performance numbers and graphs are sourced from Morningstar. NAV to NAV figures have been used.

Risk profile of the fund ranges from low risk to high risk with a low risk potentially associated with lower rewards and a high risk with potentially higher rewards.
